To our John Still families,

All students must complete the form reporting their vaccination or exemption status by 11/30/21. Thanksgiving break is a great time to schedule your student's vaccination, meet with a physician if filing an exemption and get your paperwork completed. SCUSD is also posting <u>school site and community vaccination clinic opportunities</u> on the website.

## Students Aged 11 or Younger

SCUSD does not currently require this age group to be vaccinated. All you need to do by Tuesday, November 30th is:

- 1. Submit the student form at <u>scusd.edu/reportvaccine</u>, selecting the "Not Yet Required (age 11 or under)" option.
- 2. Register your student (if not yet fully vaccinated) for COVID-19 testing at <u>scusd.edu/covid-19-testing</u>. *NOTE:* You only need to register and consent for COVID-19 testing one time a year. If you have already registered your student there are no further steps required.

## Students Aged 12 or Older

SCUSD requires vaccination. Some exemptions may apply. All you need to do by Tuesday, November 30th is:

- 1. Complete the student form at <u>scusd.edu/reportvaccine</u> and submit your student's vaccination record or valid exemption.
- 2. Register your student (if not yet fully vaccinated) for COVID-19 testing at <u>scusd.edu/covid-19-testing</u>. *NOTE:* You only need to register and consent for COVID-19 testing one time a year. If you have already registered your student there are no further steps required.
