## WINTER BREAK

Winter Break is here! We will be on Winter Break from **December 26, 2022 - January 8, 2023.** The first day back to school will be **January 9, 2023.** 

Pantry food boxes will be available during winter break on the Middle School side on Wednesday, December 28, 2022, and Wednesday, January 4, 2023, from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m., while supplies last.

The food boxes are available to **the community**, not only SCUSD families.



### KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION



To be eligible to register for kindergarten for Fall 2023, children **must be five years old on or before September 1, 2023**. Children that turn five years old from September 2, 2023, through April 2, 2024, have the opportunity to enroll in the district's <u>Transitional Kindergarten (TK) programs</u>. Information on TK registration will be available in 2023.

Parents/guardians will be able to register their child for kindergarten starting on January 11, 2023, either <u>online</u>, at the <u>Enrollment Center</u>, or at school **(available only January 10-24)**.

To register, families will need to provide **photo identification**, **address verification**, **proof of birth documentation**, **and the child's immunization record**. See the full list of <u>required enrollment documentation</u>.
